## RE: Inuvialuit Land Administration's Review of the Inuvik-Tuktoyaktuk Highway EIS for Conformity with the TOR

The ILA has compared the contents of the submitted Inuvik-Tuktoyaktuk Highway Environmental Impact Statement to the EIRB's Terms of Reference. During its review of the EIS, the ILA was unable to locate a table containing inspection requirements listed in section 13.2 Compliance Monitoring of the TOR.

## Specifically the TOR states:

The developer shall prepare a table with inspection requirements. This table will be updated throughout the life of the project to reflect the current conditions of any applicable permits, licences, and approvals. The table shall include, at a minimum, information on what inspection activity will be taken and how frequently and during which period the inspection will occur.
